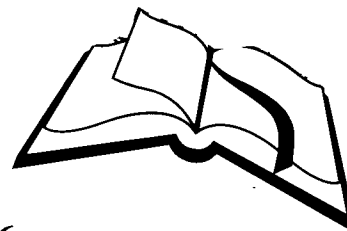


DIRECTIONS TO HOLY APOSTLES
