1. Is able to embody a spirit of unity and invite us to join her/him as one body in Christ, one Diocese of Maryland, bringing healing and reconciliation skills to this endeavor.
2. Proclaims a message of hope rooted in the Gospel.
3. Has a contagious gift for communication in all areas of ministry as a pastor, a preacher, an evangelist, and a leader.
4. Is able to discern and share a vision for the future of our diocese that will engage us all to offer our gifts in ministry.
5. Recognizes the presence of children and youth as vital members of the Body of Christ.
6. Is able to manage the resources of the diocese so that the focus may be on the mission and ministry that we are engaged in together.
7. Is a pastor to the clergy.
8. Has an understanding of the dynamics of congregational development.
9. Is experienced in the call to live out the Gospel through social justice (and helping us to work through our differences to discover how that is best achieved): entering into relationship with those who are in need so that we might all be healed.
10. Is grounded in his /her relationship with Christ through an active life of prayer, the study of the Holy Scriptures, and participation in the community of faith.
