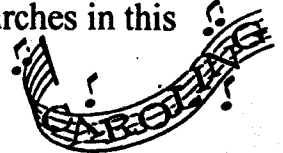
THERE ARE MANY WONDERFUL EVENTS BEING PLANNED FOR ADVENT
