The members of St. Mary's Church have been invited to join us so please come and enjoy the fellowship.

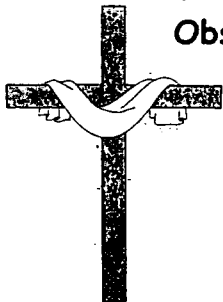
