

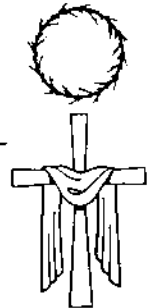

Today's lesson is from the earliest apochryphal Gospels: the Protevangelium of James. These Gospels fill in the gaps in the story of Jesus. This narrative focuses on Jesus' mother, Mary, and ends with the birth of Jesus. This tale has given rise to many of the artistic conventions connected to the figures of Mary and Joseph. It is noteworthy, above all, for its obsessive preoccupation with the virginity of Mary and the association of purity with sexuality.

Sunday, April 5 ---The Sunday of the Passion. The service begins in Reed Hall at 10:00 a.m. and then processes into the church. What begins as a triumphal entry becomes the arrest of Jesus, his trial and crucifixion. The Gospel of the Day will be The Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ according to St. Mark. The congregation will leave the church in silence as we enter the most holy week of the church year.

Wednesday, April 8- Healing Service at 9:30 a.m. followed by Bible Study.
Lenten Program will begin at 6:00 p.m. with supper, followed by The Stations of the Cross.

Thursday, April 9---Maundy Thursday Eucharist at 7:30 p.m. ending with the stripping of the altar and a time of meditation lasting until 10:00 p.m. for those who wish to remain in the sanctuary.

Friday, April 10 ---At 12:00 noon and 7:30 p.m.-- Good Friday Service remembering Jesus Death On the cross. For those who wish, there will be Eucharist from reserved sacrament.
